- 1 AN ACT Relating to driver's license examinations; amending RCW
- 2 46.20.120; and adding a new section to chapter 46.20 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 46.20.120 and 1990 c 9 s 1 are each amended to read as 5 follows:
- 6 No new driver's license may be issued and no previously issued
- 7 license may be renewed until the applicant therefor has successfully
- 8 passed a driver licensing examination. However, the department may
- 9 waive all or any part of the examination of any person applying for the
- 10 renewal of a driver's license except when the department determines
- 11 that an applicant for a driver's license is not qualified to hold a
- 12 driver's license under this title. The department may also waive the
- 13 actual demonstration of the ability to operate a motor vehicle by a
- 14 person who surrenders a valid driver's license issued by the person's
- 15 previous home state, province of Canada, or other country with which
- 16 the department has an informal agreement authorized under section 2 of
- 17 this act and who is otherwise qualified to be licensed. For a new
- 18 license examination a fee of seven dollars shall be paid by each
- 19 applicant, in addition to the fee charged for issuance of the license.

- 1 A new license is one issued to a driver who has not been previously
- 2 licensed in this state or to a driver whose last previous Washington
- 3 license has been expired for more than four years.
- 4 Any person renewing his or her driver's license more than sixty
- 5 days after the license has expired shall pay a penalty fee of ten
- 6 dollars in addition to the renewal fee under RCW 46.20.181. The
- 7 penalty fee shall be deposited in the highway safety fund.
- 8 Any person who is outside the state at the time his or her driver's
- 9 license expires or who is unable to renew the license due to any
- 10 incapacity may renew the license within sixty days after returning to
- 11 this state or within sixty days after the termination of any such
- 12 incapacity without the payment of the penalty fee.
- 13 The department shall provide for giving examinations at places and
- 14 times reasonably available to the people of this state.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.20 RCW
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (1) The department may enter into informal agreements with other
- 18 countries waiving the requirement for licensed drivers from that
- 19 country to take the driving portion of the driver's license
- 20 examination.
- 21 (2) The department may only enter into an agreement with a country
- 22 if it has procedures in place to verify the validity of drivers'
- 23 licenses issued by that country.
- 24 (3) An applicant for a Washington driver's license is eligible for
- 25 a waiver under this section only if:
- 26 (a) The applicant surrenders a valid driver's license issued to him
- 27 or her from another country; and
- 28 (b) The department has entered into an informal agreement with that
- 29 country under this section.
