- 1 AN ACT Relating to child support collection and enforcement; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 74.08A RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.08A RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The legislature finds that many families would need little or no
- 7 welfare grant assistance if they received their ordered child support
- 8 payments in a consistent, reliable, and timely manner. The legislature
- 9 also finds that recent welfare reform acts limit the amount of time
- 10 many families may receive grant assistance, making it imperative that
- 11 families become self-sufficient as quickly as possible. The
- 12 legislature therefore intends that the department of social and health
- 13 services utilize every reasonable means, including publication on the
- 14 internet, to find and secure payment from obligors who are in arrears
- 15 in their support obligations.
- 16 The secretary shall cause to be posted on the department's home
- 17 page on the internet information on obligors who are significantly in
- 18 arrears on their child support obligations. Criteria for selection of
- 19 which obligors shall be posted will be determined by the department by

- 1 rule. At a minimum, the posting shall include photographs, names, and
- 2 other identifying information for at least ten obligors who are
- 3 significantly in arrears, with a means for the public to submit
- 4 information anonymously regarding their location.
- 5 It is the intent of the legislature that this section be construed
- 6 broadly, with a goal of increasing effectiveness of support collection,
- 7 and that the department utilize its internet resources to the greatest
- 8 extent practical to accomplish this goal.
