- act, chapter 34.05 RCW, governing safety, sanitation, and water quality
- for water recreation facilities. The rules shall include but not be 8

- limited to requirements for design; operation; injury and illness

reporting; biological and chemical contamination standards; water

- quality monitoring; inspection; permit application and issuance; and 11
- 12 enforcement procedures. However, a water recreation facility intended
- 13 for the exclusive use of residents of any apartment house complex or of
- 14 a group of rental housing units of less than fifteen living units, or
