The provisions of this chapter do not apply with respect to the use 1 2 of the furnishing at a self-service motor vehicle wash and wax facility of the service of washing, waxing, and vacuuming a motor vehicle or 3 4 other tangible personal property, if the purchaser or user of the service washes, waxes, or vacuums the person's motor vehicle or other 5 tangible property at the facility, exclusively by means of automatic or 6 manually operated coin-operated devices belonging to the vendor, 8 without assistance from an employee of the vendor. For the purposes of 9 this section, "coin-operated devices" includes equipment operated by 10 tokens or currency.

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
