- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.44.200 and 1933 ex.s. c 62 s 36 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1) No person shall sell any liquor to any person apparently under 7 the influence of liquor.
- 8 (2)(a) No person who is apparently under the influence of liquor
- 9 may purchase or consume liquor on any premises licensed by the board.
- 10 (b) A violation of this subsection is an infraction punishable by
- 11 a fine of not more than five hundred dollars.
- 12 (c) A defendant's intoxication may not be used as a defense in an
- 13 <u>action under this subsection.</u>
- 14 (d) Until July 1, 2000, every establishment licensed under RCW
- 15 66.24.330 or 66.24.420 shall conspicuously post in the establishment
- 16 notice of the prohibition against the purchase or consumption of liquor
- 17 <u>under this subsection</u>.
- 18 (3) An administrative action for violation of subsection (1) of
- 19 this section and an infraction issued for violation of subsection (2)

- 1 of this section arising out of the same incident are separate actions
- 2 and the outcome of one shall not determine the outcome of the other.
