1 AN ACT Relating to seed potato production; adding a new chapter to
2 Title 15 RCW; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the production of
5 high quality certified seed potatoes within the state requires
6 conditions that are as free as possible from insect pests and plant
7 diseases and that ensuring these conditions exist is in the public
8 interest. The legislature further finds that the production of other
9 potatoes intermixed with or in close proximity to a concentrated seed
10 potato production area poses an increased risk of introduction of plant
11 diseases and insect pests.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** Growers of seed potatoes, certified in
13 accordance with rules adopted under chapter 15.14 RCW, may submit a
14 petition to the director of the department of agriculture requesting
15 that the director establish a restricted seed potato production area.
16 The petition shall include the proposed geographic boundaries of the
17 restricted seed potato production area, and the types of restrictions
18 that are proposed to apply to the growing of nonseed potatoes. The

1 petition shall contain the signatures of at least fifty percent of the
2 growers of certified seed potatoes who have produced at least fifty
3 percent of the certified seed potatoes within the proposed restricted
4 seed potato production area in each of the two preceding years.

5 Upon receipt of a petition submitted in accordance with this
6 section, the director of the department of agriculture shall, within
7 sixty days of receipt of the petition, investigate the need of
8 establishing a restricted seed potato production area. The director
9 may propose rules and hold public hearings in the area affected by the
10 proposed rules. The director has the authority to adopt rules in
11 accordance with chapter 34.05 RCW to establish restricted seed potato
12 production areas to prevent the increased exposure to plant diseases
13 and insect pests that adversely affect the ability to meet standards
14 for certification of seed potatoes established under chapter 15.14 RCW.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The director of the department of
16 agriculture may bring an action to enjoin the violation or threatened
17 violation of any provision of this chapter or any rule made pursuant to
18 this chapter in a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in
19 which such violation occurs or is about to occur.

20 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** Sections 2 and 3 of this act constitute a
21 new chapter in Title 15 RCW.

22 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** This act is necessary for the immediate
23 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
24 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
25 immediately.

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
