HB 1032-S - DIGEST

(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 2ND SUB)

Revises provisions relating to grants of rule-making authority to prohibit adoption of rules based solely on a statute's statement of intent or purpose.

Establishes rule-making requirements, including length of time rules are effective, review of existing rules, and permitted expedited rule-making.

Revises procedures for judicial review of rules.

Revises provisions for legislative review of rules.

Establishes requirements for payment of fees and expenses for appeal of the application of rules.

Requires regulatory impact notes.
