Brief Title: Defining agriculture for the purpose of safety regulations.

HB 1834-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/11/97)

Declares the term "agriculture" means farming and includes, but is not limited to: (1) The cultivation and tillage of the soil;

(2) dairying;

(3) the production, cultivation, growing, and harvesting of any agricultural or horticultural commodity;

(4) the raising of livestock, bees, fur-bearing animals, or poultry; and

(5) any practices performed by a farmer or on a farm, incident to or in connection with such farming operations, including but not limited to preparation for market and delivery to: (a) storage; (b) market; or (c) carriers for transportation to market.

Does not pertain to processing a product grown by someone else.
