Brief Title: Adjusting the method of allocating state funds to cities and towns abutting a military base or reservation.

**HB 1855 - DIGEST**

Provides that, when the corporate boundaries of a city or town abut a military base or military reservation located in the unincorporated area of a county or counties, and two or more gates of the military base or military reservation go directly from the military base or military reservation into the city or town, the population of the military base or military reservation as last determined by the office of financial management is added to the population of the city or town as last determined by the office of financial management for the purposes of computing and determining the amount of the allocation and entitlement of state moneys to be paid to the city or town.
