Brief Title: Establishing residency requirements for subsidized enrollees in the basic health plan.

**HB 2226-S - DIGEST**

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/19/97)

Declares that a "subsidized enrollee" means an individual, or an individual plus the individual's spouse or dependent children, not eligible for medicare, who has resided for at least eleven months in an area of the state served by a managed health care system participating in the plan.

Exempts seasonal workers.
