Brief Title: Requiring regional transit authority trains to be from Washington manufacturers and made in Washington.

HB 2976 - DIGEST

Declares that any regional transit authority created under this chapter that utilizes tax revenues imposed under RCW 81.104.150 through 81.104.170, shall ensure that any train sets or other rolling stock constructed, acquired, or leased by the regional transit authority are from a manufacturer that has a corporate office in Washington state and that spends at least sixty percent of the total purchase price of the equipment on the assembly and manufacture of parts in Washington state.
