Brief Title: Establishing requirements for keeping records of unified business identifier account numbers.

SB 5572 - DIGEST

Prohibits an entity from bidding on any public works contract for two years from the date that a violation is finally determined, with any person or entity who has been determined by the respective administering agency to have violated RCW 50.12.070(1)(b), 51.16.070(1)(b), or 82.32.070(1)(b).

Requires an employer who contracts with another person or entity for work subject to chapter 18.27 or 19.28 RCW to obtain and preserve a record of the unified business identifier account number for the person or entity performing the work.

Declares that a failure to obtain or maintain the record is subject to RCW 39.06.010 and to a penalty determined by the commissioner, but not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars, to be collected as provided in RCW 50.24.120.
