Brief Title: Allowing parents access to student records and prohibiting their release without parental consent.

SB 5603 - DIGEST

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Provides that the parent or guardian of a student who is or has been in attendance at a school has the right to review all education records of the student.

Declares that a school may not release the education records of a student without the written consent of the student's parent or guardian, except as authorized by RCW 28A.600.475 and the family educational and privacy rights act of 1974, 20 U.S.C. Sec. 1232g.
