Brief Title: Providing support for collaborative efforts toward worker reemployment.

**SB 6422-S - DIGEST**

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 2/12/98)

Finds that jobseekers would be better served by integrating employment and training services to form a comprehensive network of state and local programs, called a one-stop career development system.

Imposes a five thousand dollar civil penalty for release of information regarding claimants or employers.
