3 On page 14, line 32, reduce the general fund--state appropriation  
4 for fiscal year 2000 by \$250,000

5 On page 15, line 18, correct the total accordingly

6 On page 19, starting on line 23, strike all of subsection (21)

7 Renumber remaining subsections consecutively

8 On page 69, line 22, reduce the general fund--state appropriation  
9 for fiscal year 2000 by \$500,000

10 On page 69, line 30, increase the flood control assistance account  
11 appropriation by \$750,000

12 On page 70, line 32, correct the total accordingly

13 On page 71, line 29, strike all of subsections (6) and (7)

14 Renumber remaining subsections consecutively

15 On page 74, after line 18, insert the following:

16 (24) \$750,000 of the flood control assistance account  
17 appropriation is provided solely for the purpose of providing technical  
18 and financial support to local governments in developing and updating  
19 maps to accurately identify floodways and floodplains. Mapping  
20 standards shall meet or exceed the minimum standards established by the  
21 federal emergency management administration. Those watershed resource  
22 inventory areas that demonstrate a history of significant repetitive  
23 loss, including but not limited to Snohomish, Skokomish, Skagit,  
24 Yakima, and Chehalis, shall receive first priority for funding.  
25 Qualified activities include map development and generation,  
26 identification of mapping needs, developing mapping inventories, and  
27 establishing mapping standards and specifications.-

28 On page 147, after line 24, insert the following:

29 **NEW SECTION. Sec. 713. FOR THE FLOOD CONTROL ASSISTANCE ACCOUNT**

1           The sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars from the general  
2 fund--state appropriation for fiscal year 2000 shall be deposited into  
3 the flood control assistance account.-

4           Renumber the remaining sections consecutively

**EFFECT:** Eliminates the \$250,000 general fund--state support for the Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development spirit 2000 millenium celebration project. Removes \$500,000 of funds for the Department of Ecology for studies of gravel removal on Maury Island and the Highline aquifer. Transfers \$750,000 of funds from the general fund to the flood control assistance account for the Department of Ecology to develop and update maps to accurately identify floodways and flood plains in the state.
