- 8 "Sec. 1. RCW 47.64.220 and 1989 c 327 s 2 are each amended to read 9 as follows:
- 10 <u>(1)</u> Prior to collective bargaining, the marine employees'
 11 commission shall conduct a salary survey. The results of the survey
 12 shall be published in a report which shall be a public document
 13 comparing wages, hours, employee benefits, and conditions of employment
 14 of involved ferry employees with those of public and private sector
- 15 employees in states along the west coast of the United States,
- 16 including Alaska, and in British Columbia doing directly comparable but
- 17 not necessarily identical work, giving consideration to factors

- 31 survey results are inaccurate, may submit a petition to the state
- 32 <u>auditor requesting an audit of the data upon which the salary survey</u>
