- 5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 6 following:
- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that it is critical
- 8 for the success of the public school system and for the greatest
- 9 achievement of each individual student that all educators hold, and act
- 10 upon, high expectations for the academic achievement of every student.
- 11 The state's education reforms emphasize higher standards and
- 12 performance, not just "seat time" in school. No student should
- 13 graduate from high school with a diploma if the student is unable to
- 14 read. Promoting students from grade to grade without demonstrating
- 15 appropriate competencies does no service to them.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.320
- 17 RCW to read as follows:
- 18 (1) By the beginning of the 2000-01 school year, all school boards
- 19 shall adopt a policy, or amend any existing local policy if necessary,
- 20 regarding promotion and retention of students.
- 21 (2) The district policy shall be adopted at a public meeting of the
- 22 school board and shall:
- 23 (a) Provide for parental notification when a student is identified
- 24 as being at risk of retention. This notice shall be provided as early
- 25 in the school year, and as early in their school careers, as
- 26 practicable. The policy shall provide a student's parent or guardian
- 27 the opportunity to consult with the teacher or teachers responsible for
- 28 the decision to promote or retain the student; and
- 29 (b) Indicate the manner in which opportunities for remedial
- 30 instruction are available to students who are recommended for retention
- 31 or who are identified as being at risk for retention."

<u>EFFECT:</u> Creates an intent section and requires that the new or amended policy be done by the beginning of the 2000-01 school year. Makes references to "student" consistent (changes "child" and "pupil"

to "student") and requires school districts to amend existing retention and promotion policies only if necessary.
