4 **Sec. 6.** RCW 18.16.080 and 1984 c 208 s 19 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) Nothing in this chapter prohibits any person authorized under
7 the laws of this state from performing any service for which the person
8 may be licensed, nor prohibits any person from performing services as
9 an electrologist if that person has been otherwise certified,
10 registered, or trained as an electrologist.

11 (2) This chapter does not apply to persons employed in the care or
12 treatment of patients in hospitals or employed in the care of residents
13 of nursing homes and similar residential care facilities.

14 (3) This chapter does not apply to persons who provide services
15 described under this chapter when the services are incidental to those
16 provided:

17 (a) Through licensed home health, hospice, or home care agencies;

18 (b) By individual providers under contract with the department of
19 social and health services under chapter 74.09 or 74.39A RCW; or

20 (c) By personal aides providing services under chapter
21 (House Bill No. 1880), Laws of 1999.-

22 Renumber the sections consecutively, correct internal references
23 accordingly and correct the title.

EFFECT: Persons who provide home health care services, and
incidental to those services may provide cosmetology services, are
exempt from the laws governing cosmetology.
