7 "**Sec. 1.** RCW 46.52.020 and 1990 c 210 s 2 are each amended to read
8 as follows:

9 (1) A driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in
10 the injury to or death of any person shall immediately stop such
11 vehicle at the scene of such accident or as close thereto as possible
12 but shall then forthwith return to, and in every event remain at, the
13 scene of such accident until he or she has fulfilled the requirements
14 of subsection (3) of this section; every such stop shall be made
15 without obstructing traffic more than is necessary.

16 (2) The driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting
17 only in damage to a vehicle which is driven or attended by any person
18 or damage to other property shall immediately stop such vehicle at the
19 scene of such accident or as close thereto as possible and shall
20 forthwith return to, and in any event shall remain at, the scene of
21 such accident until he or she has fulfilled the requirements of
22 subsection (3) of this section; every such stop shall be made without
23 obstructing traffic more than is necessary.

24 (3) Unless otherwise provided in subsection (7) of this section the
25 driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or
26 death of any person or damage to any vehicle which is driven or
27 attended by any person or damage to other property shall give his or
28 her name, address, insurance company, insurance policy number, and
29 vehicle license number and shall exhibit his or her vehicle driver's
30 license to any person struck or injured or the driver or any occupant
31 of, or any person attending, any such vehicle collided with and shall
32 render to any person injured in such accident reasonable assistance,
33 including the carrying or the making of arrangements for the carrying
34 of such person to a physician or hospital for medical treatment if it
35 is apparent that such treatment is necessary or if such carrying is
36 requested by the injured person or on his or her behalf. Under no

1 circumstances shall the rendering of assistance or other compliance
2 with the provisions of this subsection be evidence of the liability of
3 any driver for such accident.

4 (4)(a) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (1) of
5 this section failing to stop or comply with any of the requirements of
6 subsection (3) of this section (~~((under said circumstances shall be))~~) in
7 the case of an accident resulting in death is guilty of a class B
8 felony and, upon conviction, is punishable according to chapter 9A.20
9 RCW.

10 (b) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (1) of this
11 section failing to stop or comply with any of the requirements of
12 subsection (3) of this section in the case of an accident resulting in
13 injury is guilty of a class C felony and, upon conviction, ((be
14 punished pursuant to RCW 9A.20.020: PROVIDED, That)) is punishable
15 according to chapter 9A.20 RCW.

16 (c) This ((provision)) subsection shall not apply to any person
17 injured or incapacitated by such accident to the extent of being
18 physically incapable of complying ((herewith)) with this section.

19 (5) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (2) of this
20 section failing to stop or to comply with any of the requirements of
21 subsection (3) of this section under said circumstances shall be guilty
22 of a gross misdemeanor: PROVIDED, That this provision shall not apply
23 to any person injured or incapacitated by such accident to the extent
24 of being physically incapable of complying herewith.

25 (6) The license or permit to drive or any nonresident privilege to
26 drive of any person convicted under this section or any local ordinance
27 consisting of substantially the same language as this section of
28 failure to stop and give information or render aid following an
29 accident with any vehicle driven or attended by any person shall be
30 revoked by the department.

31 (7) If none of the persons specified are in condition to receive
32 the information to which they otherwise would be entitled under
33 subsection (3) of this section, and no police officer is present, the
34 driver of any vehicle involved in such accident after fulfilling all
35 other requirements of subsections (1) and (3) of this section insofar
36 as possible on his or her part to be performed, shall forthwith report
37 such accident to the nearest office of the duly authorized police
38 authority and submit thereto the information specified in subsection
39 (3) of this section.
