9 In addition to any other power or authority that an agency may have, an agency alone or in concert with another agency may award 10 contracts for work, construction, alteration, repair, or improvement 11 projects estimated to cost less than thirty-five thousand dollars using 12 a limited public works process without advertising and competitive 13 14 bidding. An agency using the limited public works process shall solicit electronic or written quotations from a minimum of three 15 16 contractors included on the appropriate small works roster established 17 under RCW 39.04.150, making an effort to include a certified minority or certified woman-owned contractor, and shall award the contract to 18 19 the lowest responsible bidder, even if only one quotation is received, 20 or shall reject all quotations. After an award is made, the quotations 21 shall be open to public inspection and available by electronic request. Unless the agency chooses to notify all contractors on the appropriate 22 23 roster who are willing to perform work in the geographic area of the 24 work, a contractor on the appropriate roster who is willing to perform 25 work in that geographic area and who has been sent a notice of a project shall not be sent another notice of a project until all others 26 27 on the appropriate roster who are willing to perform work in the geographic area have been sent notice of a project. An agency shall 28 maintain a list each biennium of the contracts awarded under the 29 limited public works process, including the name of the contractor, the 30 31 amount of the contract, a brief description of the type of work performed, and the date it was awarded. For limited public works 32 33 projects, an agency may waive the payment and performance bond 34 requirements of chapter 39.08 RCW and the retainage requirements of 35 chapter 60.28 RCW, thereby assuming the liability for the contractor's laborers, mechanics, subcontractors, materialmen, 36 nonpayment of 37 suppliers, and taxes imposed pursuant to Title 82 RCW that may be due

- from the contractor for the limited public works project, however the agency shall have a right of recovery against the contractor for any payments made on the contractor's behalf.
- 4 (2) The breaking down of any public work or improvement into units 5 or accomplishing any public work or improvement by phases for the 6 purpose of avoiding the minimum dollar amount for bidding is contrary 7 to public policy and is prohibited.
- 8 (3) As used in this section, the term "agency" means the department 9 of general administration, the department of fish and wildlife, the 10 department of natural resources, the department of transportation, and 11 the state parks and recreation commission.
- 12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 39.04.155 and 1998 c 278 s 12 are each amended to read 13 as follows:
- (1) A municipality may use either the small works roster process as
  defined in subsection (2) of this section or an alternative small works
  roster process that is called the limited public works process as
  defined in subsection (3) of this section for work, construction,
  repair, alteration, or improvement projects.

- (2)(a) This ((section)) subsection provides a uniform process to award contracts for public works projects by those municipalities that are authorized to use a small works roster in lieu of the requirements for formal sealed bidding. The state statutes governing a specific type of municipality shall establish the maximum dollar thresholds of the contracts that can be awarded under this process, and may include other matters concerning the small works roster process, for the municipality.
- $((\frac{2}{2}))$  (b) Such municipalities may create a single general small 27 works roster, or may create a small works roster for different 28 29 categories of anticipated work. The small works roster or rosters shall consist of all responsible contractors who have requested to be 30 on the list, and where required by law are properly licensed or 31 registered to perform such work in this state. At least twice a year, 32 the municipality shall publish in a newspaper of general circulation 33 34 within the jurisdiction a notice of the existence of the roster or rosters and solicit the names of contractors for such roster or 35 36 rosters.
- The governing body of the municipality shall establish a procedure for securing ((telephone)) electronic or written quotations from the

contractors on the general small works roster, or a specific small 1 works roster for the appropriate category of work, to assure that a 2 3 competitive price is established and to award contracts to the lowest 4 responsible bidder, as defined in RCW 43.19.1911. Such invitations for quotations shall include an estimate of the scope and nature of the 5 work to be performed as well as materials and equipment to be 6 7 furnished. However, detailed plans and specifications need not be 8 included in the invitation. This section does not eliminate other 9 requirements for architectural or engineering approvals as to quality and compliance with building codes. Whenever possible at least five 10 contractors shall be invited to submit bids. Once a contractor has 11 been afforded an opportunity to submit a proposal, that contractor 12 shall not be offered another opportunity until all other appropriate 13 14 contractors on the small works roster have been afforded an opportunity 15 to submit a proposal on a contract. Proposals may be invited from all appropriate contractors on the small works roster. 16

17 A contract awarded from a small works roster under this section 18 need not be advertised.

38 39 Immediately after an award is made, the bid quotations obtained shall be recorded, open to public inspection, and available by ((telephone)) electronic inquiry.

(3)(a) Work, construction, alteration, repair, or improvement projects estimated to cost less than thirty-five thousand dollars are limited public works exempt from the small works roster process and from the requirement that contracts be awarded after advertisement and competitive bid as provided in RCW 39.04.010. For limited public works projects, the municipality shall solicit electronic or written quotations from a minimum of three contractors on the appropriate small works roster, making an effort to include a certified minority or certified woman-owned contractor, and shall award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, even if only one quotation is received, or reject all quotations. After an award is made, the quotations must be open to public inspection and available by electronic request. Unless the municipality chooses to notify all contractors on the appropriate roster, a contractor on the appropriate roster who has been sent a notice of a project shall not be sent another notice of a project until all others on the appropriate roster who are willing to perform work have been sent notice of a project.
