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5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
6 following:

7 "**Sec. 1.** RCW 67.38.160 and 1982 1st ex.s. c 22 s 16 are each  
8 amended to read as follows:

9 A cultural arts, stadium and convention district established in  
10 accordance with this chapter shall be dissolved and its affairs  
11 liquidated by either of the following methods:

12 (1) When so directed by a majority of persons in the district  
13 voting on such question. An election placing such question before the  
14 voters may be called in the following manner:

15 ~~((1))~~ (a) By resolution of the cultural arts, stadium and  
16 convention district governing authority;

17 ~~((2))~~ (b) By resolution of the county legislative body or bodies  
18 with the concurrence therein by resolution of the city council of a  
19 component city; or

20 ~~((3))~~ (c) By petition calling for such election signed by at  
21 least ten percent of the qualified voters residing within the district  
22 filed with the auditor of the county wherein the largest portion of the  
23 district is located. The auditor shall examine the same and certify to  
24 the sufficiency of the signatures thereon: PROVIDED, That to be  
25 validated, signatures must have been collected within a ninety-day  
26 period as designated by the petition sponsors.

27 With dissolution of the district, any outstanding obligations and  
28 bonded indebtedness of the district shall be satisfied or allocated by  
29 mutual agreement to the county or counties and component cities of the  
30 cultural arts, stadium and convention district.

31 (2) By submission of a petition, supported by a majority of the  
32 members on every legislative authority in favor of the petition, to the  
33 superior court of any county in which the district is located, for an  
34 order of dissolution signed by no less than two-thirds of the  
35 legislative authorities represented on the district governing body.  
36 All of the signatures must have been collected within one hundred

1 twenty days of the date of submission to the court. The procedures for  
2 dissolution provided in RCW 53.48.030 through 53.48.120 shall apply,  
3 except that the balance of any assets, after payment of all costs and  
4 expenses, shall be divided among the county or counties and component  
5 cities of the district on a per capita basis. Any duties to be  
6 performed by a county official pursuant to RCW 53.48.030 through  
7 53.48.120 shall be performed by the relevant official of the county in  
8 which the petition for dissolution is filed."

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12 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "district;" strike the  
13 remainder of the title and insert "and amending RCW 67.38.160."

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
