At least ten days, but not more than 28 twenty-five days, prior to the hearing, the commission shall publish a 29 30 paid public notice of reasonable size in display advertising form, setting forth the date, time, and place of the hearing, at least once 31 32 in one or more daily newspapers of general circulation in the county and at least once in one or more weekly newspapers circulated in the 33 34 area where the real property is located. A news release concerning the 35 public hearing must be disseminated among print and electronic media in 36 the area where the real property is located. The public notice and

- 3 A summary of the testimony presented at the public hearing shall be
- 4 prepared for the commission's consideration when reviewing the proposed

- 6 (3) If there is a failure to substantially comply with the
- 7 procedures set out under this section, then the agreement to dispose of
- 8 the real property is subject to being declared invalid by a court of
- 9 competent jurisdiction. Such a suit must be brought within one year of
- 10 the date of the real property disposal agreement."
