- (2) In addition to the authority granted by subsection (1) of this section law enforcement agencies of cities and counties shall investigate and report to the commission all violations of the provisions of this chapter and of the rules of the commission found by them and shall assist the commission in any of its investigations and proceedings respecting any such violations. Such law enforcement agencies shall not be deemed agents of the commission.
- 19 (3) In addition to its other powers and duties, the commission 20 shall have the power to enforce the penal provisions of chapter 218, Laws of 1973 1st ex. sess. and as it may be amended, and the penal laws 21 of this state relating to the conduct of or participation in gambling 22 23 activities and the manufacturing, importation, transportation, 24 distribution, possession, and sale of equipment or paraphernalia used 25 or for use in connection therewith. The director, the deputy director, both assistant directors, and each of the commission's investigators, 26 27 enforcement officers, and inspectors shall have the power, under the supervision of the commission, to enforce the penal provisions of 28 chapter 218, Laws of 1973 1st ex. sess. and as it may be amended, and 29 30 the penal laws of this state relating to the conduct of or participation in gambling activities and the manufacturing, 31 importation, transportation, distribution, possession, and sale of 32 equipment or paraphernalia used or for use in connection therewith. 33 34 They shall have the power and authority to apply for and execute all 35 warrants and serve process of law issued by the courts in enforcing the penal provisions of chapter 218, Laws of 1973 1st ex. sess. and as it 36

may be amended, and the penal laws of this state relating to the 1 2 conduct of or participation in gambling activities manufacturing, importation, transportation, distribution, possession, 3 4 and sale of equipment or paraphernalia used or for use in connection 5 therewith. They shall have the power to arrest without a warrant, any person or persons found in the act of violating any of the penal 6 7 provisions of chapter 218, Laws of 1973 1st ex. sess. and as it may be 8 amended, and the penal laws of this state relating to the conduct of or participation in gambling activities and the manufacturing, 9 importation, transportation, distribution, possession, and sale of 10 equipment or paraphernalia used or for use in connection therewith. To 11 the extent set forth above, the commission shall be a law enforcement 12 13 agency of this state with the power to investigate for violations of and to enforce the provisions of this chapter, as now law or hereafter 14 15 amended, and to obtain information from and provide information to all other law enforcement agencies. 16

(4) Criminal history record information that includes nonconviction data, as defined in RCW 10.97.030, shall be disseminated by a criminal justice agency to the Washington state gambling commission for any purpose associated with the investigation for suitability for involvement in gambling activities authorized under this chapter. The Washington state gambling commission shall only disseminate nonconviction data obtained under this section to criminal justice agencies."
