- 11 (a) For any person to operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle not equipped with mirrors on the left and right sides of the motorcycle 12 13 which shall be so located as to give the driver a complete view of the 14 highway for a distance of at least two hundred feet to the rear of the motorcycle or motor-driven cycle: PROVIDED, That mirrors shall not be 15 16 required on any motorcycle or motor-driven cycle over twenty-five years old originally manufactured without mirrors and which has been restored 17 18 to its original condition and which is being ridden to or from or otherwise in conjunction with an antique or classic motorcycle contest, 19 20 show, or other such assemblage: PROVIDED FURTHER, That no mirror is 21 required on any motorcycle manufactured prior to January 1, 1931;
  - (b) For any person to operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle which does not have a windshield unless wearing glasses, goggles, or a face shield of a type conforming to rules adopted by the state patrol;
- 24 25 (c) For any person to operate or ride upon a motorcycle, motordriven cycle, or moped on a state highway, county road, or city street 26 unless wearing upon his or her head a ((protective)) motorcycle helmet 27 28 ((of a type conforming to rules adopted by the state patrol)) except 29 when the vehicle is an antique motor-driven cycle or automobile that is licensed as a motorcycle or when the vehicle is equipped with seat 30 31 belts and roll bars approved by the state patrol. The motorcycle helmet ((must be equipped with either a)) neck or chin strap ((which 32 shall)) must be fastened securely while the motorcycle or motor-driven 33 cycle is in motion. Persons operating electric-assisted bicycles shall 34 35 comply with all laws and regulations related to the use of bicycle 36 helmets;

- 1 (d) For any person to transport a child under the age of five on a 2 motorcycle or motor-driven cycle;
- 3 (e) For any person to sell or offer for sale a motorcycle helmet 4 ((which)) that does not meet the requirements established by ((the state patrol)) this section.
- 6 (2) The state patrol ((is hereby authorized and empowered to)) may
  7 adopt and amend rules, pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act,
  8 concerning ((the)) standards ((and procedures for conformance of rules
  9 adopted)) for glasses, goggles, and face shields((, and protective helmets)).
- 11 (3) For purposes of this section, "motorcycle helmet" means a 12 protective covering for the head consisting of a hard outer shell, 13 padding adjacent to and inside the outer shell, and a neck or chin 14 strap type retention system with a sticker indicating that the 15 motorcycle helmet meets standards established by the United States

<u>EFFECT:</u> Returns the bill to its original form. The helmet consists of a hard outer shell, padding, and a neck or chin strap, and a sticker indicating that the helmet meets USDOT standards.
