7 "Sec. 1. RCW 43.19.1919 and 1997 c 264 s 2 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 (~~Except as provided in RCW 28A.335.180 and 43.19.1920,~~) The
10 division of purchasing shall sell or exchange personal property
11 belonging to the state for which the agency, office, department, or
12 educational institution having custody thereof has no further use, at
13 public or private sale, and cause the moneys realized from the sale of
14 any such property to be paid into the fund from which such property was
15 purchased or, if such fund no longer exists, into the state general
16 fund(~~(: PROVIDED,~~)). This requirement is subject to the following
17 exceptions and limitations:

18 (1) This section does not apply to property under RCW 27.53.045,
19 28A.335.180, or 43.19.1920;

20 (2) Sales of capital assets may be made by the division of
21 purchasing and a credit established in central stores for future
22 purchases of capital items as provided for in RCW 43.19.190 through
23 43.19.1939(~~(, as now or hereafter amended: PROVIDED FURTHER, That))~~;

24 (3) Personal property, excess to a state agency, including
25 educational institutions, shall not be sold or disposed of prior to
26 reasonable efforts by the division of purchasing to determine if other
27 state agencies have a requirement for such personal property. Such
28 determination shall follow sufficient notice to all state agencies to
29 allow adequate time for them to make their needs known. Surplus items
30 may be disposed of without prior notification to state agencies if it
31 is determined by the director of general administration to be in the
32 best interest of the state. The division of purchasing shall maintain
33 a record of disposed surplus property, including date and method of
34 disposal, identity of any recipient, and approximate value of the
35 property(~~(: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That this section shall)~~);

1 (4) This section does not apply to personal property acquired by a
2 state organization under federal grants and contracts if in conflict
3 with special title provisions contained in such grants or contracts;

4 (5) A state agency having a surplus personal property asset with a
5 fair market value of less than five hundred dollars may transfer the
6 asset to another state agency without charging fair market value. A
7 state agency conducting this action shall maintain adequate records to
8 comply with agency inventory procedures and state audit requirements.

10 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.09.210 and 1965 c 8 s 43.09.210 are each amended to
11 read as follows:

12 Separate accounts shall be kept for every appropriation or fund of
13 a taxing or legislative body showing date and manner of each payment
14 made therefrom, the name, address, and vocation of each person,
15 organization, corporation, or association to whom paid, and for what
16 purpose paid.

17 Separate accounts shall be kept for each department, public
18 improvement, undertaking, institution, and public service industry
19 under the jurisdiction of every taxing body.

20 All service rendered by, or property transferred from, one
21 department, public improvement, undertaking, institution, or public
22 service industry to another, shall be paid for at its true and full
23 value by the department, public improvement, undertaking, institution,
24 or public service industry receiving the same, and no department,
25 public improvement, undertaking, institution, or public service
26 industry shall benefit in any financial manner whatever by an
27 appropriation or fund made for the support of another.

28 All unexpended balances of appropriations shall be transferred to
29 the fund from which appropriated, whenever the account with an
30 appropriation is closed.

31 This section does not apply to agency surplus personal property
32 handled under RCW 43.19.1919(5)."
