The rules shall include but not be limited to:

- 29 (b) Methods to ensure that reserve accounts receive adequate funds, 30 including:
- (i) Requirements that the reserve account be generated by user fees. However, the department may waive this requirement for existing landfills if user fees would be prohibitively high;
- (ii) Requirements that moneys be placed in the reserve account on a regular basis and that the reserve account be kept separate from all other accounts; and

- (i) A list of all landfill disposal facilities, the ownership of the facilities, and whether the facilities have an affiliated interest, as defined in chapter 81.16 RCW, with a solid waste collection company; (ii) The estimated cost to close the landfill and the years to closure;
