- (2) Notwithstanding RCW ((77.12.240 or any other provisions of law)) 77.36.020 or 77.36.030, it is unlawful to hunt or pursue black bear, cougar, bobcat, or lynx with the aid of a dog or dogs.

- 9 (a) The commission shall authorize the use of dogs only within a 10 game management unit to address a specific cougar population or public safety need. This authority may only be exercised after the commission 11 has determined that no other practical alternative to the use of dogs 12 exists, and after the commission has adopted rules describing the 13 conditions in which dogs may be used. Conditions that may warrant the 14 15 use of dogs within a game management unit include, but are not limited to, confirmed cougar/human safety incidents, confirmed cougar/livestock 16 and cougar/pet depredations, and the number of cougar capture attempts 17 and relocations. 18
