7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) A task force to study the issue of the
8 office of archaeology and historic preservation is created.

9 (2)(a) The task force shall develop a single recommendation for
10 consideration by the legislature and the governor on the issue of the
11 location of the office of archaeology and historic preservation within
12 state government. The recommended location shall maximize the office
13 of archaeology and historic preservation's stature, visibility,
14 accessibility, and delivery of service state-wide in the context of its
15 critical role as an important link among downtown and neighborhood
16 revitalization efforts, the cultural tourism movement, rural economic
17 development initiatives, and the preservation of the structures and
18 sites that still remain as the legacy of Washington's rich and diverse
19 heritage.

20 (b) The task force shall consider and include in its recommendation
21 how best both to realize the potential of the office of archaeology and
22 historic preservation to generate revenue from services it could
23 provide in international, national, state, local, and private venues
24 and also how best to achieve adequate funding from all funding sources
25 to assure that the office of archaeology and historic preservation can
26 provide the best possible service to the citizens of the state.

27 (3)(a) There shall be eleven members of the task force as follows:
28 One member shall be the state historic preservation officer or his or
29 her designee; two members shall be representatives of state agencies;
30 two members shall be representatives of local governments; there shall
31 be one representative each from the Washington state historical
32 society, the eastern Washington state historical society, the
33 Washington trust for historic preservation, and Indian tribes; and two
34 members shall be representatives of the private sector who have
35 experience in preservation of historic buildings or archaeological

1 sites or who have particular interest in the issue of preservation of
2 historic buildings and archaeological sites.

3 (b) The state historic preservation officer shall be the chair of
4 the task force.

5 (c) Staff support shall be provided from the department of
6 community, trade, and economic development.

7 (3) The task force shall report to appropriate committees of the
8 legislature and the governor by January 1, 2000.

9 (4) This section expires June 30, 2000."
