- 9 (a) For any person to operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle 10 not equipped with mirrors on the left and right sides of the motorcycle which shall be so located as to give the driver a complete view of the 11 12 highway for a distance of at least two hundred feet to the rear of the 13 motorcycle or motor-driven cycle: PROVIDED, That mirrors shall not be required on any motorcycle or motor-driven cycle over twenty-five years 14 15 old originally manufactured without mirrors and which has been restored to its original condition and which is being ridden to or from or 16 otherwise in conjunction with an antique or classic motorcycle contest, 17 show, or other such assemblage: PROVIDED FURTHER, That no mirror is 18 19 required on any motorcycle manufactured prior to January 1, 1931;
  - (b) For any person to operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle which does not have a windshield unless wearing glasses, goggles, or a face shield of a type conforming to rules adopted by the state patrol;
  - (c) For any person <u>under the age of twenty-one years</u> to operate or ride upon a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, or moped on a state highway, county road, or city street unless wearing upon his or her head a protective helmet of a type conforming to rules adopted by the state patrol except when the vehicle is an antique motor-driven cycle or automobile that is licensed as a motorcycle or when the vehicle is equipped with seat belts and roll bars approved by the state patrol. The helmet must be equipped with either a neck or chin strap which shall be fastened securely while the motorcycle or motor-driven cycle is in motion. Persons operating electric-assisted bicycles shall comply with all laws and regulations related to the use of bicycle helmets;
- 35 (d) For any person to transport a child under the age of five on a 36 motorcycle or motor-driven cycle;

- 1 (e) For any person to sell or offer for sale a motorcycle helmet 2 which does not meet the requirements established by the state patrol.
- 3 (2) The state patrol is hereby authorized and empowered to adopt 4 and amend rules, pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, 5 concerning the standards and procedures for conformance of rules 6 adopted for glasses, goggles, face shields, and protective helmets.
