8 "WHEREAS, The board identified the challenge of meeting future
9 demand for college education should a greater proportion of Washington
10 citizens seek upper division and graduate level study by the year 2010;
11 and"

12 On page 3, after line 8, insert the following:

13 "BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislature reaffirm its
14 commitment to create postsecondary opportunities in response to actual
15 demand from citizens for access to high-quality education and training
16 programs; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the board reexamine its assumptions
18 with regard to projected upper division and graduate enrollments, and
19 that the plan reexamine the role of the community and technical
20 colleges in meeting the postsecondary needs of a significant portion of
21 Washington's population; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the board reexamine its assumptions
23 with regard to the capital needs of the community and technical
24 colleges and the four-year institutions of higher education, including
25 their branch campuses; and"

26 On page 3, line 9, after "approve the" insert "following"

27 On page 3, beginning on line 11, after "(1)" strike all material
28 through "(2)" on line 15

29 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any
30 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Modifies the resolution to clarify that the HECB findings about future demand for enrollments in 2010 would occur if more citizens seek upper division and graduate level study. Asks the HECB to reexamine the plan's enrollment and capital facilities assumptions with respect to community and technical colleges. Adds a legislative resolve to respond to actual demand for enrollment by citizens in future years. Removes language that approved a specific enrollment goal for the higher education system by the year 2010.
