BACKGROUND:

The Open Public Records Act (RCW 42.17) commonly known as the public disclosure law makes all public documents subject to release. Requests for numerous exemptions from public disclosure requirements codified in state and local government require disclosure of records specifically defined in a statute or exemption available for public inspection or copying.

However, the Uniform Health Care Information Act states that health providers may not disclose health care information to a patient or any other person without the patient's written authorization. Health care providers must also have disclosure of health care information specific exemptions. This requirement allows the release of health care information without written authorization.

SUMMARY:

An exception is made to the Uniform Health Care Information Act which requires that it is statutorily made available for inspection, copying, and use by a health care organization in connection with medical health research projects determined to be conducted by an institution or board.

The determination of the institution or board must meet the following requirements: project of sufficient importance to outweigh invasion of privacy; impractical to disclose the vital statistics if individual identity information is safeguarded; disclosure of personal statistics are protected against identification; report of the research project and the project contains procedures to destroy identified material at the earliest opportunity.

Vital statistics records held by government entities include name, address, gender, registration number and pertinent dates of birth, death, marriage, divorce and annulment.
