  - (3) Knowingly provides false information on his or her declaration and affidavit of candidacy or petition of nomination for an office; or
- 9 and affidavit of candidacy or petition of nomination <u>for an office</u>; or
  10 (4) Conceals or fraudulently defaces or destroys a certificate
  11 which has been filed with an elections officer under chapter 29.24 RCW
  12 or a declaration of candidacy or petition of nomination which has been
  13 filed with an elections officer, or any part of such a certificate,
  14 declaration, or petition, is guilty of a class C felony punishable
  15 under RCW 9A.20.021.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 29.85 RCW to read as follows:
- Regular law enforcement officers of the jurisdiction where a crime established under this title allegedly has occurred, including the sheriff, deputy sheriffs, police chief, police officers, town marshal, and deputy town marshals, are responsible for investigating these alleged crimes.
