- 1 AN ACT Relating to the taxation of grain warehouse companies;
- 2 amending RCW 82.04.090, 82.04.280, and 82.04.280; providing effective
- 3 dates; providing an expiration date; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.04.090 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 278 s 40 are each 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 "Value proceeding or accruing" means the consideration, whether
- 8 money, credits, rights, or other property expressed in terms of money,
- 9 actually received or accrued. The term shall be applied, in each case,
- 10 on a cash receipts or accrual basis according to which method of
- 11 accounting is regularly employed in keeping the books of the taxpayer.
- 12 However, persons operating grain warehouses licensed under chapter
- 13 22.09 RCW may elect to report the value proceeding or accruing from
- 14 grain warehouse operations on either a cash receipts or accrual basis.
- 15 The department of revenue may provide by regulation that the value
- 16 proceeding or accruing from sales on the installment plan under
- 17 conditional contracts of sale may be reported as of the dates when the
- 18 payments become due.

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1 **Sec. 2.** RCW 82.04.280 and 1994 c 112 s 1 are each amended to read 2 as follows:

3 Upon every person engaging within this state in the business of: 4 (1) Printing, and of publishing newspapers, periodicals, or magazines; 5 (2) building, repairing or improving any street, place, road, highway, easement, right of way, mass public transportation terminal or parking 6 7 facility, bridge, tunnel, or trestle which is owned by a municipal 8 corporation or political subdivision of the state or by the United 9 States and which is used or to be used, primarily for foot or vehicular 10 traffic including mass transportation vehicles of any kind including any readjustment, reconstruction or relocation of 11 facilities of any public, private or cooperatively owned utility or 12 13 railroad in the course of such building, repairing or improving, the cost of which readjustment, reconstruction, or relocation, is the 14 15 responsibility of the public authority whose street, place, road, highway, easement, right of way, mass public transportation terminal or 16 parking facility, bridge, tunnel, or trestle is being built, repaired 17 or improved; (3) extracting for hire or processing for hire; (4) 18 19 operating a cold storage warehouse or storage warehouse, but not 20 including the rental of cold storage lockers; (5) representing and performing services for fire or casualty insurance companies as an 21 independent resident managing general agent licensed under the 22 provisions of RCW 48.05.310; (6) radio and television broadcasting, 23 24 excluding network, national and regional advertising computed as a 25 standard deduction based on the national average thereof as annually 26 reported by the Federal Communications Commission, or in lieu thereof by itemization by the individual broadcasting station, and excluding 27 that portion of revenue represented by the out-of-state audience 28 29 computed as a ratio to the station's total audience as measured by the 30 100 micro-volt signal strength and delivery by wire, if any; (7) engaging in activities which bring a person within the definition of 31 consumer contained in RCW 82.04.190(6); as to such persons, the amount 32 of tax on such business shall be equal to the gross income of the 33 business multiplied by the rate of 0.484 percent. 34

As used in this section, "cold storage warehouse" means a storage warehouse used to store fresh and/or frozen perishable fruits or vegetables, meat, seafood, dairy products, or fowl, or any combination thereof, at a desired temperature to maintain the quality of the product for orderly marketing.

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As used in this section, "storage warehouse" means a building or 1 2 structure, or any part thereof, in which goods, wares, or merchandise are received for storage for compensation, except field warehouses, 3 4 fruit warehouses, fruit packing plants, warehouses licensed under chapter 22.09 RCW other than grain warehouses, public garages storing 5 automobiles, railroad freight sheds, docks and wharves, and "self-6 7 storage" or "mini storage" facilities whereby customers have direct 8 access to individual storage areas by separate entrance.

As used in this section, "periodical or magazine" means a printed publication, other than a newspaper, issued regularly at stated intervals at least once every three months, including any supplement or special edition of the publication.

13 **Sec. 3.** RCW 82.04.280 and 1998 c 343 s 3 are each amended to read 14 as follows:

15 Upon every person engaging within this state in the business of: 16 (1) Printing, and of publishing newspapers, periodicals, or magazines; (2) building, repairing or improving any street, place, road, highway, 17 18 easement, right of way, mass public transportation terminal or parking 19 facility, bridge, tunnel, or trestle which is owned by a municipal corporation or political subdivision of the state or by the United 20 States and which is used or to be used, primarily for foot or vehicular 21 22 traffic including mass transportation vehicles of any kind and 23 including any readjustment, reconstruction or relocation of the 24 facilities of any public, private or cooperatively owned utility or 25 railroad in the course of such building, repairing or improving, the cost of which readjustment, reconstruction, or relocation, is the 26 27 responsibility of the public authority whose street, place, road, highway, easement, right of way, mass public transportation terminal or 28 29 parking facility, bridge, tunnel, or trestle is being built, repaired 30 or improved; (3) extracting for hire or processing for hire; (4) operating a cold storage warehouse or storage warehouse, but not 31 including the rental of cold storage lockers; (5) representing and 32 33 performing services for fire or casualty insurance companies as an 34 independent resident managing general agent licensed under the provisions of RCW 48.05.310; (6) radio and television broadcasting, 35 36 excluding network, national and regional advertising computed as a 37 standard deduction based on the national average thereof as annually 38 reported by the Federal Communications Commission, or in lieu thereof

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- 1 by itemization by the individual broadcasting station, and excluding
- 2 that portion of revenue represented by the out-of-state audience
- 3 computed as a ratio to the station's total audience as measured by the
- 4 100 micro-volt signal strength and delivery by wire, if any; (7)

- 6 consumer contained in RCW 82.04.190(6); as to such persons, the amount
- 7 of tax on such business shall be equal to the gross income of the

- 9 As used in this section, "cold storage warehouse" means a storage

- 12 thereof, at a desired temperature to maintain the quality of the
- 13 product for orderly marketing.

- 20 storage" or "mini storage" facilities whereby customers have direct

- 22 warehouse" does not include a building or structure, or that part of
- 23 such building or structure, in which an activity taxable under RCW
- 24 82.04.272 is conducted.
- 25 As used in this section, "periodical or magazine" means a printed
- 26 publication, other than a newspaper, issued regularly at stated
- 27 intervals at least once every three months, including any supplement or
- 28 special edition of the publication.
- 29 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Section 2 of this act expires July 1, 2001.
- 30 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** (1) Section 3 of this act takes effect July
- 31 1, 2001.
- 32 (2) Sections 1 and 2 of this act are necessary for the immediate
- 33 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 34 state government and its existing public institutions, and take effect
- 35 July 1, 1999.

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
