1 AN ACT Relating to custodial sexual misconduct; amending RCW
2 43.43.830 and 70.125.030; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.320; adding
3 new sections to chapter 9A.44 RCW; adding a new section to chapter
4 72.09 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) A person is guilty of custodial sexual misconduct in the first
9 degree when the person has sexual intercourse with another person:

10 (a)(i) Who is a resident of a state, county, or city adult or
11 juvenile correctional facility, including but not limited to jails,
12 prisons, detention centers, or work release facilities, or (ii) who is
13 under correctional supervision; and the perpetrator is an employee or
14 contract personnel of a correctional agency and the perpetrator has, or
15 the resident reasonably believes the perpetrator has, the ability to
16 influence the terms, conditions, length, or fact of incarceration or
17 correctional supervision; or

18 (b) Who is being detained, under arrest or in the custody of a law
19 enforcement officer and the perpetrator is a law enforcement officer.

1 (2) Consent of the victim is not a defense to a prosecution under
2 this section.

3 (3) Custodial sexual misconduct in the first degree is a class C
4 felony.

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 (1) A person is guilty of custodial sexual misconduct in the second
8 degree when the person has sexual contact with another person:

9 (a)(i) Who is a resident of a state, county, or city adult or
10 juvenile correctional facility, including but not limited to jails,
11 prisons, detention centers, or work release facilities, or (ii) who is
12 under correctional supervision; and the perpetrator is an employee or
13 contract personnel of a correctional agency and the perpetrator has, or
14 the resident reasonably believes the perpetrator has, the ability to
15 influence the terms, conditions, length, or fact of incarceration or
16 correctional supervision; or

17 (b) Who is being detained, under arrest, or in the custody of a law
18 enforcement officer and the perpetrator is a law enforcement officer.

19 (2) Consent of the victim is not a defense to a prosecution under
20 this section.

21 (3) Custodial sexual misconduct in the second degree is a gross
22 misdemeanor.

6 **Sec. 4.** RCW 43.43.830 and 1998 c 10 s 1 are each amended to read
7 as follows:

8 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in
9 this section apply throughout RCW 43.43.830 through 43.43.840.

10 (1) "Applicant" means:

11 (a) Any prospective employee who will or may have unsupervised
12 access to children under sixteen years of age or developmentally
13 disabled persons or vulnerable adults during the course of his or her
14 employment or involvement with the business or organization;

15 (b) Any prospective volunteer who will have regularly scheduled
16 unsupervised access to children under sixteen years of age,
17 developmentally disabled persons, or vulnerable adults during the
18 course of his or her employment or involvement with the business or
19 organization under circumstances where such access will or may involve
20 groups of (i) five or fewer children under twelve years of age, (ii)
21 three or fewer children between twelve and sixteen years of age, (iii)
22 developmentally disabled persons, or (iv) vulnerable adults; or

23 (c) Any prospective adoptive parent, as defined in RCW 26.33.020.

24 (2) "Business or organization" means a business or organization
25 licensed in this state, any agency of the state, or other governmental
26 entity, that educates, trains, treats, supervises, houses, or provides
27 recreation to developmentally disabled persons, vulnerable adults, or
28 children under sixteen years of age, including but not limited to
29 public housing authorities, school districts, and educational service
30 districts.

31 (3) "Civil adjudication" means a specific court finding of sexual
32 abuse or exploitation or physical abuse in a dependency action under
33 RCW 13.34.040 or in a domestic relations action under Title 26 RCW. In
34 the case of vulnerable adults, civil adjudication means a specific
35 court finding of abuse or financial exploitation in a protection
36 proceeding under chapter 74.34 RCW. It does not include administrative
37 proceedings. The term "civil adjudication" is further limited to court
38 findings that identify as the perpetrator of the abuse a named

1 individual, over the age of eighteen years, who was a party to the
2 dependency or dissolution proceeding or was a respondent in a
3 protection proceeding in which the finding was made and who contested
4 the allegation of abuse or exploitation.

5 (4) "Conviction record" means "conviction record" information as
6 defined in RCW 10.97.030(3) relating to a crime against children or
7 other persons committed by either an adult or a juvenile. It does not
8 include a conviction for an offense that has been the subject of an
9 expungement, pardon, annulment, certificate of rehabilitation, or other
10 equivalent procedure based on a finding of the rehabilitation of the
11 person convicted, or a conviction that has been the subject of a
12 pardon, annulment, or other equivalent procedure based on a finding of
13 innocence. It does include convictions for offenses for which the
14 defendant received a deferred or suspended sentence, unless the record
15 has been expunged according to law.

16 (5) "Crime against children or other persons" means a conviction of
17 any of the following offenses: Aggravated murder; first or second
18 degree murder; first or second degree kidnaping; first, second, or
19 third degree assault; first, second, or third degree assault of a
20 child; first, second, or third degree rape; first, second, or third
21 degree rape of a child; first or second degree robbery; first degree
22 arson; first degree burglary; first or second degree manslaughter;
23 first or second degree extortion; indecent liberties; incest; vehicular
24 homicide; first degree promoting prostitution; communication with a
25 minor; unlawful imprisonment; simple assault; sexual exploitation of
26 minors; first or second degree criminal mistreatment; child abuse or
27 neglect as defined in RCW 26.44.020; first or second degree custodial
28 interference; first or second degree custodial sexual misconduct;
29 malicious harassment; first, second, or third degree child molestation;
30 first or second degree sexual misconduct with a minor; patronizing a
31 juvenile prostitute; child abandonment; promoting pornography; selling
32 or distributing erotic material to a minor; custodial assault;
33 violation of child abuse restraining order; child buying or selling;
34 prostitution; felony indecent exposure; criminal abandonment; or any of
35 these crimes as they may be renamed in the future.

36 (6) "Crimes relating to drugs" means a conviction of a crime to
37 manufacture, delivery, or possession with intent to manufacture or
38 deliver a controlled substance.

1 (7) "Crimes relating to financial exploitation" means a conviction
2 for first, second, or third degree extortion; first, second, or third
3 degree theft; first or second degree robbery; forgery; or any of these
4 crimes as they may be renamed in the future.

5 (8) "Disciplinary board final decision" means any final decision
6 issued by a disciplining authority under chapter 18.130 RCW or the
7 secretary of the department of health for the following businesses or
8 professions:

- 9 (a) Chiropractic;
- 10 (b) Dentistry;
- 11 (c) Dental hygiene;
- 12 (d) Massage;
- 13 (e) Midwifery;
- 14 (f) Naturopathy;
- 15 (g) Osteopathic medicine and surgery;
- 16 (h) Physical therapy;
- 17 (i) Physicians;
- 18 (j) Practical nursing;
- 19 (k) Registered nursing; and
- 20 (l) Psychology.

21 "Disciplinary board final decision," for real estate brokers and
22 salespersons, means any final decision issued by the director of the
23 department of licensing for real estate brokers and salespersons.

24 (9) "Unsupervised" means not in the presence of:

25 (a) Another employee or volunteer from the same business or
26 organization as the applicant; or

27 (b) Any relative or guardian of any of the children or
28 developmentally disabled persons or vulnerable adults to which the
29 applicant has access during the course of his or her employment or
30 involvement with the business or organization.

31 (10) "Vulnerable adult" means "vulnerable adult" as defined in
32 chapter 74.34 RCW, except that for the purposes of requesting and
33 receiving background checks pursuant to RCW 43.43.832, it shall also
34 include adults of any age who lack the functional, mental, or physical
35 ability to care for themselves.

36 (11) "Financial exploitation" means the illegal or improper use of
37 a vulnerable adult or that adult's resources for another person's
38 profit or advantage.

1 (12) "Agency" means any person, firm, partnership, association,
2 corporation, or facility which receives, provides services to, houses
3 or otherwise cares for vulnerable adults.

4 **Sec. 5.** RCW 70.125.030 and 1996 c 123 s 6 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 As used in this chapter and unless the context indicates otherwise:

7 (1) "Core services" means treatment services for victims of sexual
8 assault including information and referral, crisis intervention,
9 medical advocacy, legal advocacy, support, and system coordination.

10 (2) "Department" means the department of community, trade, and
11 economic development.

12 (3) "Law enforcement agencies" means police and sheriff's
13 departments of this state.

14 (4) "Personal representative" means a friend, relative, attorney,
15 or employee or volunteer from a community sexual assault program or
16 specialized treatment service provider.

17 (5) "Rape crisis center" means a community-based social service
18 agency which provides services to victims of sexual assault.

19 (6) "Community sexual assault program" means a community-based
20 social service agency that is qualified to provide and provides core
21 services to victims of sexual assault.

22 (7) "Sexual assault" means one or more of the following:

23 (a) Rape or rape of a child;

24 (b) Assault with intent to commit rape or rape of a child;

25 (c) Incest or indecent liberties;

26 (d) Child molestation;

27 (e) Sexual misconduct with a minor;

28 (f) Custodial sexual misconduct;

29 (g) Crimes with a sexual motivation; or

30 ~~((+g))~~ (h) An attempt to commit any of the aforementioned
31 offenses.

32 (8) "Specialized services" means treatment services for victims of
33 sexual assault including support groups, therapy, specialized sexual
34 assault medical examination, and prevention education to potential
35 victims of sexual assault.

36 (9) "Victim" means any person who suffers physical and/or mental
37 anguish as a proximate result of a sexual assault.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 72.09 RCW
2 to read as follows:

3 Before reporting an alleged violation of section 1 or 2 of this act
4 to a prosecuting attorney, the department shall conduct an
5 investigation to determine whether there is probable cause to believe
6 the allegation is true.
