- 1 AN ACT Relating to real estate research; adding new sections to
- 2 chapter 18.85 RCW; and providing expiration dates.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.85 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) A fee of ten dollars is created and shall be assessed on each
- 7 real estate broker, associate broker, and salesperson originally
- 8 licensed after October 1, 1999, and upon each renewal of a license with
- 9 an expiration date after October 1, 1999, including renewals of
- 10 inactive licenses.
- 11 (2) This section expires September 30, 2005.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 18.85 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (1) The Washington real estate research account is created in the
- 15 state treasury. All receipts from the fee under section 1 of this act
- 16 shall be deposited into the account. Expenditures from the account may
- 17 be used only for the purposes of section 3 of this act.
- 18 (2) This section expires September 30, 2005.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 18.85 RCW to read as follows:
- 3 (1) The purpose of a real estate research center in Washington 4 state is to provide credible research, value-added information,
- 5 education services, and project-oriented research to real estate
- 6 licensees, real estate consumers, real estate service providers,
- 7 institutional customers, public agencies, and communities in Washington
- 8 state and the Pacific Northwest region. The center may:
- 9 (a) Conduct studies and research on affordable housing and 10 strategies to meet the affordable housing needs of the state;
- (b) Conduct studies in all areas directly or indirectly related to real estate and urban or rural economics and economically isolated communities;
- 14 (c) Disseminate findings and results of real estate research 15 conducted at or by the center or elsewhere, using a variety of 16 dissemination media;
- 17 (d) Supply research results and educational expertise to the 18 Washington state real estate commission to support its regulatory 19 functions, as requested;
- (e) Prepare information of interest to real estate consumers and make the information available to the general public, universities, or colleges, and appropriate state agencies;
- (f) Encourage economic growth and development within the state of Washington;
- 25 (g) Support the professional development and continuing education 26 of real estate licensees in Washington;
- 27 (h) Study and recommend changes in state statutes relating to real 28 estate; and
- (i) Publish, within three months of the conclusion of each fiscal year, a report that includes both a content review and a summary financial reporting of the public funds expended by the center.
- 32 (2) The director shall establish a memorandum of understanding with 33 an institution of higher learning that establishes a real estate 34 research center for the purposes under subsection (1) of this section.
- 35 (3) This section expires September 30, 2005.
