- 1 AN ACT Relating to the temporary development of shorelines; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 90.58 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 90.58 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- A person who uses a shoreline location for the production of motion pictures is exempt from the substantial development provisions of this chapter if all of the following apply:
- 9 (1) The motion picture project does not interfere with the normal 10 public use of surface waters;
- 11 (2) The project will have no significant adverse impact on the 12 environment including, but not limited to fish, wildlife, fish or 13 wildlife habitat, water quality, and aesthetic values;
- 14 (3) Notice is provided to the local government before the start of 15 a motion picture project that a shoreline location is intended for such 16 use, and that such use shall be for a period of one year or less;
- 17 (4) An assessment is provided to the local government, before the 18 start of a motion picture project, of the vegetation, land

- 1 configurations, and other conditions to which the intended shoreline 2 location will be restored upon completion of the project; and
- 3 (5) A performance bond or other evidence of financial 4 responsibility is provided to the local government before the start of 5 a motion picture project to ensure that the site is returned to the 6 condition assessed in subsection (4) of this section, or to an improved 7 condition. Evidence of financial assurance shall be provided within 8 three weeks of providing notice to the local government.
