1 AN ACT Relating to applying the same restrictions on soliciting and
2 receiving contributions to persons who are newly elected as state
3 officials that are applicable to state officials; and amending RCW
4 42.17.710.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.17.710 and 1993 c 2 s 11 are each amended to read
7 as follows:

8 During the period beginning on the thirtieth day before the date a
9 regular legislative session convenes and continuing thirty days past
10 the date of final adjournment, and during the period beginning on the
11 date a special legislative session convenes and continuing through the
12 date that session adjourns, no state official or a person employed by
13 or acting on behalf of a state official (~~(or state legislator)~~), and no
14 person who has been elected as a state official but has not taken
15 office or a person employed by or acting on behalf of such a person,
16 may solicit or accept contributions to a public office fund, to a
17 candidate or authorized committee, or to retire a campaign debt.
