 - (c) How the registration of a voter may be challenged;
- 6 (d) A discussion of the county canvassing board and how election 7 results are canvassed and certified;
- 8 (e) A discussion of write-in voting and the tallying of write-in 9 votes;
- 10 (f) The circumstances and procedures when a true duplicate copy of 11 a ballot will be made;
 - (g) A discussion of observers appointed by major political parties;
- 13 (h) A discussion of the circumstances and procedures for making 14 appeals to the canvassing board;
- 15 (i) A discussion of the recount of votes; and
