- AN ACT Relating to election costs; and amending RCW 29.13.047.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.13.047 and 1985 c 45 s 2 are each amended to read 4 as follows:
- (1) Whenever state officers or measures are voted upon at a state primary or general election held in an odd-numbered year under RCW 29.13.010, the state of Washington shall assume a prorated share of the costs of that state primary or general election.
- 9 (2) Whenever state officers or measures are voted upon at a state 10 primary or general election held in an even-numbered year under RCW 11 29.13.010, the state of Washington shall assume a prorated share of the 12 costs of the primary or election according to the following schedule:
- 13 <u>(a) 2000, twenty-five percent;</u>
- 14 <u>(b) 2002, fifty percent;</u>
- 15 (c) 2004, seventy-five percent; and
- 16 (d) 2006 and thereafter, one hundred percent.
- 17 <u>(3)</u> Whenever a primary or vacancy election is held to fill a 18 vacancy in the position of United States senator or United States
- 19 representative under chapter 29.68 RCW, the state of Washington shall

- 1 assume a prorated share of the costs of that primary or vacancy 2 election.
- $((\frac{3}{3}))$  (4) The county auditor shall apportion the state's share of these expenses when prorating election costs under RCW 29.13.045 and shall file such expense claims with the secretary of state.
- 6 (((4))) (5) The secretary of state shall include in his or her 7 biennial budget requests sufficient funds to carry out this section.
- 8 Reimbursements for election costs shall be from appropriations 9 specifically provided by law for that purpose.
