- 1 AN ACT Relating to rental payments to landlords from public
- 2 assistance; and adding a new section to chapter 74.04 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Persons receiving public assistance, particularly families,
- 7 frequently have great difficulty obtaining adequate housing. The
- 8 department of social and health services is directed to conduct a
- 9 program designed to increase the supply of housing for persons on
- 10 public assistance by making rental payments directly to the landlords.
- 11 (2) The department shall explore the use of public and private
- 12 housing providers in the implementation of the program.
- 13 (3) The department shall solicit not less than three and up to
- 14 seven local governing bodies for participation in the program. In
- 15 implementing this program the department shall:
- 16 (a) Stress that participation in the program by recipients on
- 17 public assistance is voluntary;
- 18 (b) Utilize the services of either local public or private housing
- 19 providers, or both, to the maximum extent feasible; and

- 1 (c) Give consideration to obtaining a geographic distribution and 2 balance throughout the state when selecting participating local 3 governing bodies.
- 4 (4) Prior to the convening of the 2000 regular session of the 5 legislature, the department shall report the results of the program, 6 together with its recommendations, to the co-chairs of the house of 7 representatives committee on economic development, housing and trade 8 and the chair of the senate committee on labor and workforce 9 development.
