- 1 AN ACT Relating to the administration of irrigation districts;
- 2 amending RCW 87.84.010; and adding new sections to chapter 87.03 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 87.03 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Any irrigation district organized under this chapter may, for
- 7 compensation, reimbursement, or otherwise, within limits established by
- 8 the state Constitution, assist the owners of land receiving water
- 9 distributed by the irrigation district or discharging, with the
- 10 district's approval, water from the land into irrigation district-
- 11 maintained facilities to finance, acquire, install, lease, and use
- 12 equipment, fixtures, programs, and systems to conserve, improve,
- 13 preserve, and efficiently use the land, water delivered by the
- 14 irrigation district, or water discharged from the land into irrigation
- 15 district-maintained facilities. Assistance may include, but is not
- 16 limited to, grants, loans, and financing to purchase, lease, install,
- 17 and use approved conservation, improvement, and preservation equipment,
- 18 fixtures, programs, and systems. The equipment, fixtures, programs,
- 19 and systems may be leased, purchased, or installed by a private

- 1 business, the owner of the land, or the irrigation district.
- 2 "Conserve," "improve," and "preserve" as used in this section, include
- 3 enhancing the quality of water delivered by the irrigation district or
- 4 discharged from the land into irrigation district-maintained
- 5 facilities.
- 6 (2) The district may charge the owner and the land if district
- 7 money or credit is used or extended to provide the assistance in
- 8 subsection (1) of this section. The district's board of directors may
- 9 also levy and fix assessments, rates, tolls, and charges and collect
- 10 them from all persons for whom, and all land on which, district money
- 11 or credit is provided, or the board may require landowner repayment for
- 12 landowner assistance by assessments, charges, rates, or tolls in the
- 13 same manner as provided by RCW 87.03.445.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 87.03 RCW
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 All contracts entered into by irrigation districts for the purchase
- 17 of materials, equipment, supplies, or services may be awarded to
- 18 vendors pursuant to telephone or written quotations or both in
- 19 accordance with the uniform process established in RCW 39.04.190.
- 20 **Sec. 3.** RCW 87.84.010 and 1988 c 127 s 67 are each amended to read
- 21 as follows:
- 22 Any irrigation district having ((the)) a major portion of an inland
- 23 navigable body of water within or along its exterior boundaries and
- 24 ((which)) that (1) has filed with the department of ecology and been
- 25 granted a water right certificate or (2) holds a legally recognized
- 26 water right through the United States bureau of reclamation, for return
- 27 <u>river flows or otherwise</u>, for fifty thousand acre feet of water or
- 28 more, and regardless of whether the water right is withdrawn from the
- 29 body of water itself or one of its tributaries, shall be eligible to
- 30 become an irrigation and rehabilitation district as provided in this
- 31 chapter.

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
