- 1 AN ACT Relating to the registration of surgical technologists;
- 2 amending RCW 18.130.040; and adding a new chapter to Title 18 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Surgical technology, an allied health
- 5 occupation, provides certain skills and aseptic techniques associated
- 6 with the scrub role during surgery. The registration of surgical
- 7 technologists is in the interest of the public health, safety, and
- 8 welfare.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The definitions in this section apply
- 10 throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- 11 (1) "Department" means the department of health.
- 12 (2) "Secretary" means the secretary of health or the secretary's designee.
- 14 (3) "Surgical technologist" means a person registered under this
- 15 chapter to practice surgical technology under the supervision and
- 16 delegation of a physician, osteopathic physician, podiatric physician,
- 17 nurse, or physician assistant licensed under the laws of this state.

- 1 (4) "Surgical technology" means scrub activities and behaviors in 2 the surgical setting, including the maintenance of the integrity, 3 safety, and efficiency of the sterile field and the preparation, 4 arrangement, and provision of instruments and supplies to the surgeon 5 and assistant throughout the surgical procedure. "Surgical technology" 6 does not include controlling hemostasis, suturing, or tying or placing
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** No person may perform surgical technology or represent oneself as a surgical technologist by use of any title or description without being registered by the department under the provisions of this chapter.

sutures in any tissues.

- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** Nothing in this chapter may be construed to prohibit or restrict:
- 14 (1) The practice of an individual licensed, certified, or 15 registered under the laws of this state and performing services within 16 his or her authorized scope of practice;
- 17 (2) The practice by an individual employed by the government of the 18 United States while engaged in the performance of duties prescribed by 19 the laws of the United States;
- 20 (3) The practice by a person who is a regular student in an 21 educational program approved by the secretary, and whose performance of 22 services is pursuant to a regular course of instruction or assignments 23 from an instructor and under the general supervision of the instructor.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. In addition to any other authority provided by law, the secretary has the authority to:
- 26 (1) Adopt rules under chapter 34.05 RCW as required to implement 27 this chapter;
- 28 (2) Establish all registration and renewal fees in accordance with 29 RCW 43.70.250;
- 30 (3) Establish forms and procedures necessary to administer this 31 chapter;
- 32 (4) Register an applicant or deny registration based upon 33 unprofessional conduct or impairment governed by the uniform 34 disciplinary act, chapter 18.130 RCW;
- 35 (5) Hire clerical, administrative, investigative, and other staff 36 as needed to implement this chapter; and

- 1 (6) Maintain the official department record of all applicants and 2 persons with registrations.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. An applicant shall identify the name and address of the applicant and other information required by the secretary necessary to establish whether there are grounds for denial of a registration or conditional registration under chapter 18.130 RCW.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. The secretary shall register an applicant on forms provided by the secretary. Each applicant shall pay a fee determined by the secretary under RCW 43.70.250. The fee shall accompany the application.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 8. The secretary shall establish by rule the procedural requirements and fees for renewal of registration. Failure to renew shall invalidate the registration and all privileges granted by the registration.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 9.** The uniform disciplinary act, chapter 18.130 RCW, governs unregistered practice, the issuance and denial of registration, and the discipline of persons registered under this chapter. The secretary shall be the disciplining authority under this chapter.
- 20 **Sec. 10.** RCW 18.130.040 and 1998 c 243 s 16 are each amended to 21 read as follows:
- (1) This chapter applies only to the secretary and the boards and commissions having jurisdiction in relation to the professions licensed under the chapters specified in this section. This chapter does not apply to any business or profession not licensed under the chapters specified in this section.
- 27 (2)(a) The secretary has authority under this chapter in relation 28 to the following professions:
- 29 (i) Dispensing opticians licensed under chapter 18.34 RCW;

- 6 (viii) The board of pharmacy as established in chapter 18.64 RCW 7 governing licenses issued under chapters 18.64 and 18.64A RCW;
- 8 (ix) The medical quality assurance commission as established in 9 chapter 18.71 RCW governing licenses and registrations issued under 10 chapters 18.71 and 18.71A RCW;
- 11 (x) The board of physical therapy as established in chapter 18.74 12 RCW;
- 13 (xi) The board of occupational therapy practice as established in 14 chapter 18.59 RCW;
- 15 (xii) The nursing care quality assurance commission as established 16 in chapter 18.79 RCW governing licenses issued under that chapter;
- 17 (xiii) The examining board of psychology and its disciplinary 18 committee as established in chapter 18.83 RCW; and
- 19 (xiv) The veterinary board of governors as established in chapter 20 18.92 RCW.
- (3) In addition to the authority to discipline license holders, the 21 disciplining authority has the authority to grant or deny licenses 22 based on the conditions and criteria established in this chapter and 23 24 the chapters specified in subsection (2) of this section. This chapter also governs any investigation, hearing, or proceeding relating to 25 26 denial of licensure or issuance of a license conditioned on the 27 applicant's compliance with an order entered pursuant to RCW 18.130.160 by the disciplining authority. 28
- (4) All disciplining authorities shall adopt procedures to ensure substantially consistent application of this chapter, the Uniform Disciplinary Act, among the disciplining authorities listed in subsection (2) of this section.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 11.** Sections 1 through 9 of this act constitute a new chapter in Title 18 RCW.
