- AN ACT Relating to assaults upon persons performing public service;
- 2 amending RCW 9A.36.031; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 9A.36.031 and 1998 c 94 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A person is guilty of assault in the third degree if he or she, 7 under circumstances not amounting to assault in the first or second 8 degree:
- 9 (a) ((With intent to prevent or resist the execution of any lawful 10 process or mandate of any court officer or the lawful apprehension or 11 detention of himself or another person, assaults another; or
- (b) Assaults a person employed as a transit operator or driver by
 a public or private transit company while that person is performing his
 or her official duties at the time of the assault; or
- (c) Assaults a school bus driver employed by a school district or
 a private company under contract for transportation services with a
 school district while the driver is performing his or her official

duties at the time of the assault; or

- 1 (d))) With criminal negligence, causes bodily harm to another 2 person by means of a weapon or other instrument or thing likely to 3 produce bodily harm; or
- 4 (((e) Assaults a fire fighter or other employee of a fire 5 department, county fire marshal's office, county fire prevention 6 bureau, or fire protection district who was performing his or her 7 official duties at the time of the assault; or
- 8 (f)) (b) With criminal negligence, causes bodily harm accompanied 9 by substantial pain that extends for a period sufficient to cause 10 considerable suffering; or
- 11 ((g) Assaults a law enforcement officer or other employee of a law 12 enforcement agency who was performing his or her official duties at the 13 time of the assault; or
- 14 (h) Assaults a nurse, physician, or health care provider who was 15 performing his or her nursing or health care duties at the time of the assault. For purposes of this subsection: "Nurse" means a person 16 licensed under chapter 18.79 RCW; "physician" means a person licensed 17 under chapter 18.57 or 18.71 RCW; and "health care provider" means a 18 19 person certified under chapter 18.71 or 18.73 RCW who performs 20 emergency medical services or a person regulated under Title 18 RCW and employed by, or contracting with, a hospital licensed under chapter 21 22 70.41 RCW.))
- (c) Assaults a person who is employed by a public entity or by a private entity on contract to a public entity to provide or perform a public service while that person is in the performance of the person's official duties; or
- 27 (d) Assaults a person who is employed to provide any medical or 28 health care service, treatment, or care while that person is in the 29 performance of the person's official duties.
 - (2) Assault in the third degree is a class C felony.
