- 1 AN ACT Relating to creating an education specialist for transient
- 2 children; and creating new sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The department of social and health
- 5 services shall establish a pilot project to create an education
- 6 specialist position to coordinate information and services for
- 7 transient children attending school. The department shall issue a
- 8 request for proposal to establish a position or positions of education
- 9 specialist for transient children. The education specialist shall:
- 10 (a) Be employed by a nonprofit organization;
- (b) Be provided work space in a school district facility;
- 12 (c) Seek to minimize the educational disruption faced by transient
- 13 children;
- 14 (d) Ensure the educational component of the passport required under
- 15 RCW 74.13.285 is completed; and
- 16 (e) Provide transient children with postsecondary education
- 17 guidance and counseling.
- 18 (2) The department shall require potential bidders to establish an
- 19 advisory committee comprised of representatives of the participating

- 1 school district, the local office of the department of social and
- 2 health services, and nonprofit organizations.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** For the purposes of this act, "transient
- 4 children" means a foster child, homeless child, or migrant child.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The department of social and health services
- 6 shall report back to the appropriate committees of the senate and house
- 7 of representatives by December 5, 2000.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
- 9 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by
- 10 June 30, 1999, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and
- 11 void.
