- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. The legislature finds that the national NEW SECTION. 5 highway and traffic safety administration has established minimum 6 performance specifications for speed measuring devices. international association of chiefs of police, in cooperation with the national highway and traffic safety administration, has tested various 8 radar speed measuring devices using the testing standards in the 9 10 minimum performance specifications. Radar devices that are designed and constructed to provide accurate measurements of the speed of moving 11 12 vehicles when properly calibrated and operated are approved for use as 13 police traffic radar speed measuring devices. The national highway and 14 traffic safety administration publishes a consumer products list of 15 those radar devices. The legislature finds that those devices are 16 sufficiently reliable when properly calibrated and operated that a 17 court may take judicial notice of their reliability.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.63 RCW to read as follows:

In a hearing held to contest the determination that a traffic infraction has been committed, the court may take judicial notice of the reliability of the design, construction, and function of a radar speed measuring device if the device has been approved by the national highway and traffic safety administration for use as a police traffic radar speed measuring device and is contained in the national highway and traffic safety administration's published consumer products list of approved radar devices.

11 This section does not abrogate the rules of evidence that govern 12 other foundational requirements to admit radar test results such as the 13 proper calibration and operation of the particular radar device.
