- 1 AN ACT Relating to fish and wildlife; amending RCW 75.40.020,
- 2 75.40.110, 77.17.020, 77.12.470, 77.12.480, and 77.12.490; adding a new
- 3 chapter to Title 77 RCW; and recodifying RCW 75.40.010, 75.40.020,
- 4 75.40.030, 75.40.040, 75.40.100, 75.40.110, 77.17.010, 77.17.020,
- 5 77.17.030, 77.12.450, 77.12.470, 77.12.480, 77.12.490, 75.40.060,
- 6 77.12.430, and 77.12.440.

State of Washington

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 8 **Sec. 1.** RCW 75.40.020 and 1995 1st sp.s. c 2 s 19 are each amended 9 to read as follows:
- 10 The commission may give to the state of Oregon such consent and
- 11 approbation of the state of Washington as is necessary under the
- 12 compact set out in RCW 75.40.010 (as recodified by this act). For the
- 13 purposes of RCW 75.40.010 (as recodified by this act), the states of
- 14 Washington and Oregon have concurrent jurisdiction in the concurrent
- 15 waters of the Columbia river as defined in RCW 75.08.011 (as recodified
- 16 by chapter . . ., Laws of 1999).
- 17 Sec. 2. RCW 75.40.110 and 1994 c 148 s 2 are each amended to read
- 18 as follows:

- 1 Until such time as the agencies in California, Idaho, Oregon, and
- 2 Washington present a final proposed interstate compact for enactment by
- 3 their respective legislative bodies, the governor may establish
- 4 cooperative agreements with the states of California, Idaho, and Oregon
- 5 that allow the states to coordinate their individual efforts in
- 6 developing state programs that further the region-wide goals set forth
- 7 under RCW 75.40.100 (as recodified by this act).
- 8 Sec. 3. RCW 77.17.020 and 1994 c 264 s 56 are each amended to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 For purposes of Article VII of RCW 77.17.010 (as recodified by this
- 11 <u>act)</u>, the term "licensing authority," with reference to this state,
- 12 means the department. The director is authorized to appoint a compact
- 13 administrator.
- 14 Sec. 4. RCW 77.12.470 and 1980 c 78 s 63 are each amended to read
- 15 as follows:
- To enforce RCW 77.12.480 and 77.12.490 (as recodified by this act),
- 17 courts in the counties contiguous to the boundary waters, fish and
- 18 wildlife ((agents)) officers, and ex officio fish and wildlife
- 19 ((agents)) officers have jurisdiction over the boundary waters to the
- 20 furthermost shoreline. This jurisdiction is concurrent with the courts
- 21 and law enforcement officers of Idaho.
- 22 **Sec. 5.** RCW 77.12.480 and 1980 c 78 s 64 are each amended to read
- 23 as follows:
- 24 The taking of wildlife from the boundary waters or islands of the
- 25 Snake river shall be in accordance with the wildlife laws of the
- 26 respective states. <u>Fish and wildlife ((agents)) officers</u> and ex
- 27 officio <u>fish and</u> wildlife ((<del>agents</del>)) <u>officers</u> shall honor the license
- 28 of either state and the right of the holder to take wildlife from the
- 29 boundary waters and islands in accordance with the laws of the state
- 30 issuing the license.
- 31 **Sec. 6.** RCW 77.12.490 and 1980 c 78 s 65 are each amended to read
- 32 as follows:
- The purpose of RCW 77.12.450 through 77.12.490 (as recodified by
- 34 this act) is to avoid the conflict, confusion, and difficulty of
- 35 locating the state boundary in or on the boundary waters and islands of

- 1 the Snake river. These sections do not allow the holder of a
- 2 Washington license to fish or hunt on the shoreline, sloughs, or
- 3 tributaries on the Idaho side, nor allow the holder of an Idaho license
- 4 to fish or hunt on the shoreline, sloughs, or tributaries on the
- 5 Washington side.
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. A new chapter is added to Title 77 RCW and
- 7 is named "Compacts and other agreements." The following sections are
- 8 recodified under the following subchapter headings:
- 9 (1) "Columbia river compact" as follows:
- 10 RCW 75.40.010; and
- 11 RCW 75.40.020.
- 12 (2) "Pacific marine fisheries compact" as follows:
- 13 RCW 75.40.030; and
- 14 RCW 75.40.040.
- 15 (3) "Coastal ecosystems compact" as follows:
- 16 RCW 75.40.100; and
- 17 RCW 75.40.110.
- 18 (4) "Wildlife violator compact" as follows:
- 19 RCW 77.17.010;
- 20 RCW 77.17.020; and
- 21 RCW 77.17.030.
- 22 (5) "Snake river boundary" as follows:
- 23 RCW 77.12.450;
- 24 RCW 77.12.470;
- 25 RCW 77.12.480; and
- 26 RCW 77.12.490.
- 27 (6) "Miscellaneous" as follows:
- 28 RCW 75.40.060;
- 29 RCW 77.12.430; and
- 30 RCW 77.12.440.
