- 2 77.15.260; adding a new section to chapter 77.15 RCW; and prescribing

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.15 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 A person who is authorized to take or hunt any marine mammal in the
- 8 waters of the state or of the United States for subsistence reasons may
- 9 not act for commercial purposes as defined in RCW 77.15.110, and may
- 10 not sell or attempt to sell any such marine mammal in whole or in part.
- 11 **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.15.260 and 1998 c 190 s 42 are each amended to read
- 12 as follows:
- 13 (1) A person is guilty of unlawful trafficking in fish or wildlife
- 14 in the second degree if the person traffics in fish or wildlife with a
- 15 wholesale value of less than two hundred fifty dollars and:
- 16 (a) The fish or wildlife is classified as game, food fish,
- 17 shellfish, game fish, or protected wildlife and the trafficking is not
- 18 authorized by statute or rule of the department; or

- 1 (b) The fish or wildlife is unclassified and the trafficking 2 violates any rule of the department.
- 3 (2) A person is guilty of unlawful trafficking in fish or wildlife 4 in the first degree if the person commits the act described by 5 subsection (1) of this section and:
- 6 (a) The fish or wildlife has a value of two hundred fifty dollars 7 or more; $((\frac{\partial \mathbf{r}}{\partial \mathbf{r}}))$
- 8 (b) The fish or wildlife is designated as endangered or deleterious 9 exotic wildlife and such trafficking is not authorized by any statute 10 or rule of the department; or
- 11 <u>(c) The fish or wildlife belongs to a species of marine mammal that</u>
 12 <u>may be taken or hunted only for subsistence purposes.</u>
- 13 (3)(a) Unlawful trafficking in fish or wildlife in the second 14 degree is a gross misdemeanor.
- 15 (b) Unlawful trafficking in fish or wildlife in the first degree is 16 a class C felony.
