- 1 AN ACT Relating to membership of the Puget Sound council; and
- 2 amending RCW 90.71.030.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.71.030 and 1996 c 138 s 4 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) There is established the Puget Sound council composed of
- 7 ((nine)) eleven members. Seven members shall be appointed by the
- 8 governor. In making these appointments, the governor shall include
- 9 representation from business, the environmental community, agriculture,
- 10 the shellfish industry, counties, cities, and the tribes. ((One)) Two
- 11 members shall be ((a)) members of the senate, one from each major
- 12 <u>caucus</u>, selected by the president of the senate and ((one)) <u>two</u> members
- 13 shall be ((a)) members of the house of representatives, one from each
- 14 major caucus, selected by the speaker of the house of representatives.
- 15 The legislative members shall be nonvoting members of the council.
- 16 Appointments to the council shall reflect geographical balance and the
- 17 diversity of population within the Puget Sound basin. Members shall
- 18 serve four-year terms. Of the initial members appointed to the
- 19 council, two shall serve for two years, two shall serve for three

- 1 years, and two shall serve for four years. Thereafter members shall be
- 2 appointed to four-year terms. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment
- 3 in the same manner as the original appointment for the remainder of the
- 4 unexpired term of the position being vacated. Nonlegislative members
- 5 shall be reimbursed for travel expenses as provided in RCW 43.03.050
- 6 and 43.03.060. Legislative members shall be reimbursed as provided in
- 7 RCW 44.04.120.
- 8 (2) The council shall:
- 9 (a) Recommend to the action team projects and activities for 10 inclusion in the biennial work plan;
- 11 (b) Recommend to the action team coordination of work plan
- 12 activities with other relevant activities, including but not limited
- 13 to, agencies' activities other than those funded through the plan,
- 14 local plan initiatives, and governmental and nongovernmental watershed
- 15 restoration and protection activities; and
- 16 (c) Recommend to the action team proposed amendments to the Puget
- 17 Sound management plan.
- 18 (3) The chair of the action team shall convene the council at least
- 19 four times per year and shall jointly convene the council and the
- 20 action team at least two times per year.
