- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 79.01 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 All management responsibility, supervision and control, records,
- 7 leases, contracts, and other powers and duties for lands held in trust
- 8 for the use and support of agricultural colleges are transferred from
- 9 the commissioner of public lands and the board of natural resources to
- 10 the board of regents of Washington State University.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 79.01 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- In addition to the powers conferred upon the board of regents of
- 14 Washington State University by chapter 28B.30 RCW, the board of regents
- 15 of Washington State University has full control of the agricultural
- 16 college lands held in trust for the use and support of agricultural
- 17 colleges including but not limited to:

- 1 (1) The authority to manage, supervise, control, improve, sell, 2 acquire, maintain records, contract, and lease the land or valuable 3 materials and any improvements on the land;
- 4 (2) The authority to contract with any private or government entity 5 for the management, stewardship, sale, and removal or extraction of 6 timber or other valuable materials;
- 7 (3) Any and all powers and responsibilities given to the 8 commissioner of public lands or the board of natural resources under 9 this Title for public lands; and
- 10 (4) The authority to invest, borrow, contract indebtedness, and 11 issue bonds from the revenues or proceeds for the sale of the 12 agricultural college lands.
