1 AN ACT Relating to public assistance recipients participating in  
2 higher education programs; and amending RCW 74.08A.250.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.08A.250 and 1997 c 58 s 311 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, as used in this  
7 chapter, "work activity" means:

8 (1) Unsubsidized paid employment in the private or public sector;

9 (2) Subsidized paid employment in the private or public sector,  
10 including employment through the state work-study program for a period  
11 not to exceed twenty-four months;

12 (3) Work experience, including work associated with the  
13 refurbishing of publicly assisted housing, if sufficient paid  
14 employment is not available;

15 (4) On-the-job training;

16 (5) Job search and job readiness assistance;

17 (6) Community service programs;

18 (7) Vocational educational training, not to exceed twelve months  
19 with respect to any individual;

- 1 (8) Job skills training directly related to employment;
- 2 (9) Education directly related to employment, in the case of a  
3 recipient who has not received a high school diploma or a GED;
- 4 (10) Satisfactory attendance at secondary school or in a course of  
5 study leading to a GED, in the case of a recipient who has not  
6 completed secondary school or received such a certificate;
- 7 (11) The provision of child care services to an individual who is  
8 participating in a community service program; ((and))
- 9 (12) Internships, that shall be paid or unpaid work experience  
10 performed by an intern in a business, industry, or government or  
11 nongovernmental agency setting;
- 12 (13) Practicums, which include any educational program in which a  
13 student is working under the close supervision of a professional in an  
14 agency, clinic, or other professional practice setting for purposes of  
15 advancing their skills and knowledge; and
- 16 (14) Services required by the recipient under RCW 74.08.025(3) and  
17 74.08A.010(3) to become employable.
